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General Terms and Conditions for Services and Invoicing of Le Verseau Sports, Arts et Langues (VSAL)

- 1. Registration for activities** Invoices issued by Le Verseau Sports, Arts et Langues (VSAL) relate exclusively to services connected with the extracurricular activities offered to children registered by their parents, in accordance with the registration procedures established by the Association. VSAL reserves the right to refuse a registration, or registration for certain specific activities, without being required to state the reasons for its decision.
- 2. Fees and possible allocation of any surplus** Extracurricular activities are invoiced at the rates set each year by the Association's Board of Directors. Pupils who are duly enrolled at École Internationale Le Verseau but do not take part in extracurricular activities are not subject to these charges. At the end of the financial year, if the Association records a surplus, this may, after any reserves and provisions considered necessary have been set aside, be transferred, by decision of the Board of Directors, to the non-profit association Les Amis du Verseau.
- 3. Invoicing and payment terms** Invoices for the following school year are issued in June of each year. Full payment made before 15 July qualifies for a 5% discount. Participation in extracurricular activities may only be authorised if at least 50% of the invoiced amount has been paid by 15 August. If payment is made in instalments: a first instalment of 50% must be paid by 15 August; a second instalment of 25% must be paid by 30 November; the remaining balance must be paid by 28 February of the following year. Any failure to pay may result in the pupil being immediately excluded from extracurricular activities.
- 4. Renewal of registration** Registration for extracurricular activities is entered into for one school year and is automatically renewed from year to year, unless notice of withdrawal is given within the required deadline. The parent who completed the registration may choose not to renew for the following school year, provided that VSAL is informed no later than 31 May of the current school year: either by e-mail with acknowledgement of receipt; or by registered post. If no such notice is received by that deadline, the registration will automatically be renewed for the following school year.
- 5. Exceptional right of withdrawal** As an exceptional measure, parents who have registered their child benefit from a right of withdrawal. For this right to be validly exercised, notice must be given either by e-mail with acknowledgement of receipt; or by registered post with acknowledgement of receipt. Where the right of withdrawal is validly exercised, the following conditions shall apply: if notice of withdrawal is given before 30 September of the relevant school year, a refund of up to 75% of the amounts due may be granted, without ever exceeding the amounts actually paid; if notice of withdrawal is given after 30 September and before 31 October, a refund of up to 50% of the amounts due may be granted, without ever exceeding the amounts actually paid; if notice of withdrawal is given after 31 October and before 30 November, a refund of up to 25% of the amounts due may be granted, without ever exceeding the amounts actually paid; if notice of withdrawal is given after 30 November, no refund may be granted. Any request for withdrawal submitted outside these deadlines, or not made in one of the forms set out above, shall not give rise to any refund.
- 6. Organisation of activities** Extracurricular activities are organised with due care, in accordance with the arrangements normally applicable to this type of activity. If a teacher or activity leader is absent for a valid reason, or if an activity cannot take place due to unforeseen circumstances, VSAL will make reasonable efforts, where possible, to arrange a replacement or offer an alternative solution. However, VSAL cannot guarantee that a replacement will be provided in every case, and no refund or compensation shall be due on that basis.
- 7. Applicable code of conduct** Registration for extracurricular activities implies acceptance of the applicable code of conduct, which applies to both parents and pupils. This code of conduct is communicated at the time of first registration. VSAL reserves the right to amend it from one year to the next, and parents undertake to comply with the version in force during the relevant school year. The rules applicable within École Internationale Le Verseau, as the host site of the activities, must also be respected.
- 8. Discipline and exclusion** If the applicable code of conduct or the obligations connected with extracurricular activities are not respected, the person responsible for extracurricular activities and/or the person delegated with day-to-day management may impose a disciplinary measure, including the suspension or exclusion of the pupil. Before any final decision on exclusion is taken, the pupil and his or her parents will be invited to attend a meeting in order to be heard. If the pupil and/or the parents do not attend this meeting, the procedure may nevertheless continue. Any decision to exclude a pupil shall be reasoned and communicated in writing. In the event of exclusion, no refund shall be due.
- 9. Absences** To ensure appropriate follow-up of the activities, any foreseeable absence of a pupil must be notified in advance. In the event of an unjustified absence from an extracurricular activity, VSAL declines all responsibility for the supervision of the pupil during that period.
- 10. Insurance** VSAL holds civil liability insurance covering possible faults or omissions causing damage. Any compensation that may be payable is strictly limited to the amount covered by this insurance. The maximum amount of cover is communicated at the beginning of each school year.
- 11. Governing law and competent courts** These terms and conditions are governed by Belgian law. In the event of a dispute, only the courts of Nivelles shall have jurisdiction.
